Subject: Amendments SOLAS 74, CHAPTER XI-1, SECIAL MEASURES TO ENHANCE MARITIME

SAFETY, REG.7 "ATMOSPHERE TESTING INSTRUMENT FOR ENCLOSED SPACES".

Dear Sirs,

Kindly be informed, that as per IMO Resolution MSC.380(94), the amendments have been accepted to the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS), 1974, Chapter XI-1 Special Measures to Enhance Maritime Safety, Regulation 7 "Atmosphere testing instrument for enclosed spaces". The mentioned Regulation will become mandatory for every ship to which SOLAS 74, Chapter I applies, starting from the 01st of July 2016. Kindly find below text of IMO Resolution MSC.380(94):

CHAPTER XI-1 SPECIAL MEASURES TO ENHANCE MARITIME SAFETY

The following new Regulation 7 is added after existing regulation 6:

"Regulation 7 – Atmosphere testing instrument for enclosed spaces

Every ship to which chapter I applies shall carry an appropriate portable atmosphere capable testing instrument or instruments*. As minimum, these shall be measuring concentrations of flammable hydrogen oxygen, gases or vapours, sulphide and carbon monoxide prior to entry into enclosed spaces**. Instruments may satisfy carried under other requirements this regulation. Suitable means shall provided for the calibration instruments.

selection of portable Refer the Guidelines to facilitate the atmosphere testing instruments XI-1/7 by SOLAS (MSC.1/Circ.1477). enclosed spaces as required regulation Refer to Revised recommendations for entering enclosed spaces aboard ships (resolution A.1050(27))."
